




Queen Elizabeth I

In Norwich, Thomas was met by the Mayor, who said, "Welcome, please help us prepare for a royal pageant."




Thomas said, "First you will need to clean, repair and paint the city."



"Then we will create some poetry, music and drama. 8




Finally, Thomas promised to write a document so everyone would remember how Norwich put on a royal pageant.


200 years later the document was very old and fragile.




100 years later, the room at Norwich Castle was FULL!









Norwich Central Library caught fire.
