




Norwich is vile, streets covered in filth and poo in a pile!"




The citizen's replied, "no wonder you're sad, there's so much to do. "So let's get to work and make Norwich like new!"₈





Over the next few weeks, the citizens started to prepare for a pageant.


Plasters: "We're plastering the walls."
